



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Comanche , Texas [48093]**

Comanche is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 13,660 ranked 148th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Comanche had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,722. This PCPI ranked 117th in the state and was 78 percent of the state average, \$29,045, and 74 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.6 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.6 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Comanche was \$14,834 and ranked 119th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Comanche had a total personal income (TPI) of \$310,378\*. This TPI ranked 137th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Comanche was \$197,813\* and ranked 133rd in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 8.0 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.5 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Comanche. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 54.2 percent of TPI (compared with 52.8 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 21.6 percent (compared with 25.2 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 24.3 percent (compared with 22.0 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 10.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.7 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 4.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Comanche increased from \$141,635\* in 2000 to \$156,304\* in 2001, an increase of 10.4 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$96,593\* to the 2001 estimate was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
