



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Freestone , Texas [48161]**

Freestone is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 18,104 ranked 125th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Freestone had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,371. This PCPI ranked 199th in the state and was 67 percent of the state average, \$29,045, and 63 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.2 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.6 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Freestone was \$14,244 and ranked 151st in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Freestone had a total personal income (TPI) of \$350,689\*. This TPI ranked 129th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Freestone was \$224,338\* and ranked 126th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 6.3 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.5 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Freestone. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 59.2 percent of TPI (compared with 57.5 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.1 percent (compared with 22.6 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.7 percent (compared with 19.9 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 7.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.5 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 4.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Freestone increased from \$175,973\* in 2000 to \$203,092\* in 2001, an increase of 15.4 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$131,759\* to the 2001 estimate was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
