



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Limestone , Texas [48293]**

Limestone is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 22,045 ranked 109th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Limestone had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,604. This PCPI ranked 172nd in the state and was 71 percent of the state average, \$29,045, and 67 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 8.0 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.6 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Limestone was \$14,204 and ranked 155th in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Limestone had a total personal income (TPI) of \$454,211\*. This TPI ranked 115th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Limestone was \$298,747\* and ranked 108th in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 8.0 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.5 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Limestone. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 59.1 percent of TPI (compared with 60.0 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.4 percent (compared with 18.9 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 25.5 percent (compared with 21.2 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 9.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.9 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 4.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Limestone increased from \$253,887\* in 2000 to \$282,051\* in 2001, an increase of 11.1 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$182,230\* to the 2001 estimate was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
