



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Zavala , Texas [48507]**

Zavala is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2001 population of 11,552 ranked 157th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Zavala had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$11,802. This PCPI ranked 253rd in the state and was 41 percent of the state average, \$29,045, and 39 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 8.5 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 2.6 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Zavala was \$7,400 and ranked 251st in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Zavala had a total personal income (TPI) of \$136,340\*. This TPI ranked 193rd in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Zavala was \$90,314\* and ranked 191st in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 8.1 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.5 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.1 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Zavala. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 49.8 percent of TPI (compared with 53.6 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 10.9 percent (compared with 13.0 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 39.3 percent (compared with 33.5 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 8.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 6.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.9 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 3.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Zavala increased from \$72,018\* in 2000 to \$77,688\* in 2001, an increase of 7.9 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$57,369\* to the 2001 estimate was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.5 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.
