



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001 Natrona , Wyoming [56025]**

Natrona is one of 23 counties in Wyoming. It is part of the [Casper, WY \(MSA\)](#). Its 2001 population of 66,863 ranked 2nd in the state.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Natrona had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$33,482. This PCPI ranked 2nd in the state and was 110 percent of the state average, \$30,374, and 109 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.3 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 6.7 percent and the national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Natrona was \$21,905 and ranked 2nd in the state. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 4.4 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Natrona had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,238,726\*. This TPI ranked 2nd in the state and accounted for 15.0 percent of the state total. In 1991 the TPI of Natrona was \$1,364,933\* and ranked 2nd in the state. The 2001 TPI reflected a decrease of 0.8 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 state change was 6.5 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.6 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Natrona. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 65.9 percent of TPI (compared with 62.6 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 22.1 percent (compared with 26.3 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.0 percent (compared with 11.1 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings decreased 2.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 0.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.9 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 5.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.9 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Natrona decreased from \$1,670,598\* in 2000 to \$1,640,592\* in 2001, a decrease of 1.8 percent. The 2000-2001 state change was 8.5 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$949,377\* to the 2001 estimate was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 5.8 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
