



## **BEARFACTS 1991 – 2001**

### **Salt Lake City-Ogden-Clearfield (BEA-EA) [57142]**

Salt Lake City-Ogden-Clearfield is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2001 population of 2,163,464 ranked 34th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Salt Lake City-Ogden-Clearfield had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,983. This PCPI ranked 100th in the United States and was 82 percent of the national average, \$30,582. The 2001 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.4 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 2.5 percent. In 1991 the PCPI of Salt Lake City-Ogden-Clearfield was \$15,586 and ranked 138th in the United States. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.4 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2001 Salt Lake City-Ogden-Clearfield had a total personal income (TPI) of \$54,050,141\*. This TPI ranked 35th in the United States. In 1991 the TPI of Salt Lake City-Ogden-Clearfield was \$26,598,937\* and ranked 46th in the United States. The 2001 TPI reflected an increase of 5.5 percent from 2000. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.5 percent. The 1991-2001 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.6 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Salt Lake City-Ogden-Clearfield. In 2001 net earnings accounted for 73.6 percent of TPI (compared with 71.2 in 1991); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.2 percent (compared with 17.8 in 1991); and personal current transfer receipts were 10.2 percent (compared with 11.0 in 1991). From 2000 to 2001 net earnings increased 5.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.3 percent. From 1991 to 2001 net earnings increased on average 7.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.5 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Salt Lake City-Ogden-Clearfield increased from \$42,205,889\* in 2000 to \$44,575,305\* in 2001, an increase of 5.6 percent. The 2000-2001 national change was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1991 estimate of \$21,353,877\* to the 2001 estimate was 7.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.8 percent.
