



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Canyon , Idaho [16027]**

Canyon is one of 44 counties in Idaho. It is part of the [Boise City-Nampa, ID \(MSA\)](#). Its 2002 population of 144,949 ranked 2nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Canyon had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,376. This PCPI ranked 38th in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$25,234, and 63 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 2.1 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 0.8 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Canyon was \$14,666 and ranked 28th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Canyon had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,808,575\*. This TPI ranked 2nd in the state and accounted for 8.3 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Canyon was \$1,422,723\* and ranked 2nd in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 2.1 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.4 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.3 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Canyon. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 66.2 percent of TPI (compared with 66.2 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.7 percent (compared with 16.6 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 19.1 percent (compared with 17.3 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 0.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.9 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 7.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Canyon decreased from \$1,821,322\* in 2001 to \$1,791,233\* in 2002, a decrease of 1.7 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.5 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$978,555\* to the 2002 estimate was 6.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.1 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
