



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Osborne , Kansas [20141]**

Osborne is one of 105 counties in Kansas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2002 population of 4,261 ranked 76th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Osborne had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$20,335. This PCPI ranked 93rd in the state and was 70 percent of the state average, \$28,979, and 66 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected a decrease of 6.2 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 0.9 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Osborne was \$18,545 and ranked 28th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 0.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.9 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Osborne had a total personal income (TPI) of \$86,646\*. This TPI ranked 80th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Osborne was \$88,127\* and ranked 75th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 7.8 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.3 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 0.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Osborne. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 40.1 percent of TPI (compared with 51.8 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 30.8 percent (compared with 27.2 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 29.0 percent (compared with 20.9 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 15.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.8 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings decreased on average 2.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Osborne decreased from \$46,405\* in 2001 to \$39,931\* in 2002, a decrease of 14.0 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.6 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$49,483\* to the 2002 estimate was - 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
