



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Adams , Nebraska [31001]**

Adams is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is part of the Hastings, NE Micropolitan SA. Its 2002 population of 31,691 ranked 10th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Adams had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$24,820. This PCPI ranked 30th in the state and was 85 percent of the state average, \$29,225, and 80 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.5 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 1.8 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Adams was \$18,553 and ranked 24th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Adams had a total personal income (TPI) of \$786,579\*. This TPI ranked 11th in the state and accounted for 1.6 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Adams was \$557,472\* and ranked 10th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 1.9 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Adams. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 57.2 percent of TPI (compared with 63.5 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 25.5 percent (compared with 22.2 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.4 percent (compared with 14.2 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 1.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.6 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 2.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Adams increased from \$533,936\* in 2001 to \$543,051\* in 2002, an increase of 1.7 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$407,743\* to the 2002 estimate was 2.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
