



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Storey , Nevada [32029]**

Storey is one of 17 counties in Nevada. It is part of the [Reno-Sparks, NV \(MSA\)](#). Its 2002 population of 3,398 ranked 15th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Storey had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,274. This PCPI ranked 5th in the state and was 95 percent of the state average, \$30,784, and 95 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI remained unchanged from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 0.1 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Storey was \$19,253 and ranked 9th in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.4 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Storey had a total personal income (TPI) of \$99,474\*. This TPI ranked 14th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Storey was \$50,020\* and ranked 15th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected a decrease of 0.5 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 8.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Storey. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 69.3 percent of TPI (compared with 75.0 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 22.0 percent (compared with 15.5 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 8.8 percent (compared with 9.6 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 2.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 2.6 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 6.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 10.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Storey increased from \$40,454\* in 2001 to \$43,618\* in 2002, an increase of 7.8 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was 3.0 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$20,343\* to the 2002 estimate was 7.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 8.2 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
