



BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002

Le Flore , Oklahoma [40079]

Le Flore is one of 77 counties in Oklahoma. It is part of the [Fort Smith, AR-OK \(MSA\)](#). Its 2002 population of 48,324 ranked 14th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Le Flore had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,841. This PCPI ranked 53rd in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$25,891, and 64 percent of the national average, \$30,838. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.3 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change was -0.5 percent and the national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Le Flore was \$13,166 and ranked 63rd in the state. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.1 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2002 Le Flore had a total personal income (TPI) of \$958,783*. This TPI ranked 19th in the state and accounted for 1.1 percent of the state total. In 1992 the TPI of Le Flore was \$577,335* and ranked 20th in the state. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 0.9 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 state change remained unchanged and the national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Le Flore. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 60.6 percent of TPI (compared with 61.3 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 12.5 percent (compared with 13.3 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.9 percent (compared with 25.5 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings decreased 0.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 12.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 13.3 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 5.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.8 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Le Flore decreased from \$432,891* in 2001 to \$431,535* in 2002, a decrease of 0.3 percent. The 2001-2002 state change was - 0.3 percent and the national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$257,700* to the 2002 estimate was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
