



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos (MSA) [41740]**

San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2002 population of 2,908,091 ranked 17th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$34,612. This PCPI ranked 30th in the United States and was 112 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.4 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos was \$21,831 and ranked 58th in the United States. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos had a total personal income (TPI) of \$100,655,726\*. This TPI ranked 16th in the United States. In 1992 the TPI of San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos was \$56,610,690\* and ranked 16th in the United States. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 3.8 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 70.0 percent of TPI (compared with 66.9 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.5 percent (compared with 20.7 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 11.4 percent (compared with 12.3 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 4.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.0 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 6.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in San Diego-Carlsbad-San Marcos increased from \$75,317,745\* in 2001 to \$79,062,228\* in 2002, an increase of 5.0 percent. The 2001-2002 national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$42,211,585\* to the 2002 estimate was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.
