



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **Appleton-Oshkosh-Neenah (BEA-EA) [57009]**

Appleton-Oshkosh-Neenah is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2002 population of 805,826 ranked 81st in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Appleton-Oshkosh-Neenah had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,176. This PCPI ranked 39th in the United States and was 95 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.3 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of Appleton-Oshkosh-Neenah was \$19,247 and ranked 48th in the United States. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 Appleton-Oshkosh-Neenah had a total personal income (TPI) of \$23,511,178\*. This TPI ranked 74th in the United States. In 1992 the TPI of Appleton-Oshkosh-Neenah was \$13,743,067\* and ranked 76th in the United States. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 3.3 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Appleton-Oshkosh-Neenah. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 69.5 percent of TPI (compared with 68.9 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.7 percent (compared with 18.6 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.7 percent (compared with 12.5 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 3.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 2.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.9 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 5.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Appleton-Oshkosh-Neenah increased from \$17,839,991\* in 2001 to \$18,498,699\* in 2002, an increase of 3.7 percent. The 2001-2002 national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$10,732,981\* to the 2002 estimate was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.
