



## **BEARFACTS 1992 – 2002**

### **San Antonio (BEA-EA) [57144]**

San Antonio is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2002 population of 2,056,421 ranked 35th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 San Antonio had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,053. This PCPI ranked 87th in the United States and was 85 percent of the national average, \$30,821. The 2002 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.2 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 0.8 percent. In 1992 the PCPI of San Antonio was \$17,064 and ranked 114th in the United States. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2002 San Antonio had a total personal income (TPI) of \$53,576,738\*. This TPI ranked 37th in the United States. In 1992 the TPI of San Antonio was \$29,174,044\* and ranked 44th in the United States. The 2002 TPI reflected an increase of 2.1 percent from 2001. The 2001-2002 national change was 1.8 percent. The 1992-2002 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of San Antonio. In 2002 net earnings accounted for 69.3 percent of TPI (compared with 66.8 in 1992); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.3 percent (compared with 18.3 in 1992); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.4 percent (compared with 14.9 in 1992). From 2001 to 2002 net earnings increased 2.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.5 percent. From 1992 to 2002 net earnings increased on average 6.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in San Antonio increased from \$39,794,603\* in 2001 to \$40,798,909\* in 2002, an increase of 2.5 percent. The 2001-2002 national change was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1992 estimate of \$21,568,876\* to the 2002 estimate was 6.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
