



BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

Bristol Bay Borough , Alaska [02060]

Bristol Bay Borough is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 1,103 ranked 26th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Bristol Bay Borough had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$36,427. This PCPI ranked 4th in the state and was 112 percent of the state average, \$32,543, and 116 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected a decrease of 3.2 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 0.9 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Bristol Bay Borough was \$29,283 and ranked 2nd in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 2.9 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Bristol Bay Borough had a total personal income (TPI) of \$40,179*. This TPI ranked 26th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Bristol Bay Borough was \$49,078* and ranked 23rd in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected a decrease of 6.1 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was - 2.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.7 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Bristol Bay Borough. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 66.8 percent of TPI (compared with 80.3 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.1 percent (compared with 11.6 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.1 percent (compared with 8.0 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings decreased 7.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 9.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 2.0 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings decreased on average 3.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.4 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Bristol Bay Borough increased from \$54,760* in 2002 to \$59,661* in 2003, an increase of 9.0 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$60,363* to the 2003 estimate was - 0.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.4 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
