



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Crawford , Indiana [18025]**

Crawford is one of 92 counties in Indiana. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 10,969 ranked 86th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Crawford had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,203. This PCPI ranked 85th in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$28,917, and 70 percent of the national average, \$31,530. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.8 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.1 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Crawford was \$13,654 and ranked 92nd in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.9 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Crawford had a total personal income (TPI) of \$243,543\*. This TPI ranked 86th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Crawford was \$138,311\* and ranked 88th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 5.0 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Crawford. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 66.5 percent of TPI (compared with 62.3 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 10.7 percent (compared with 13.8 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 22.8 percent (compared with 23.9 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 8.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 11.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.8 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 6.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Crawford increased from \$85,257\* in 2002 to \$96,818\* in 2003, an increase of 13.6 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$43,613\* to the 2003 estimate was 8.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
