



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Deschutes , Oregon [41017]**

Deschutes is one of 36 counties in Oregon. It is part of the [Bend, OR \(MSA\)](#). Its 2003 population of 129,292 ranked 7th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Deschutes had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,969. This PCPI ranked 5th in the state and was 98 percent of the state average, \$29,607, and 92 percent of the national average, \$31,530. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.0 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.2 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Deschutes was \$20,272 and ranked 4th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Deschutes had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,745,396\*. This TPI ranked 7th in the state and accounted for 3.6 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Deschutes was \$1,785,163\* and ranked 7th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 6.1 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.2 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 7.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Deschutes. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 62.0 percent of TPI (compared with 61.8 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 22.7 percent (compared with 24.6 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.3 percent (compared with 13.6 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 7.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.1 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 7.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 9.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Deschutes increased from \$2,416,207\* in 2002 to \$2,613,003\* in 2003, an increase of 8.1 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$1,225,887\* to the 2003 estimate was 7.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.8 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
