



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **San Patricio , Texas [48409]**

San Patricio is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [Corpus Christi, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2003 population of 67,026 ranked 48th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 San Patricio had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,754. This PCPI ranked 147th in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$29,436, and 72 percent of the national average, \$31,530. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.1 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of San Patricio was \$13,907 and ranked 211th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 San Patricio had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,525,137\*. This TPI ranked 49th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of San Patricio was \$866,762\* and ranked 49th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 5.4 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of San Patricio. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 69.0 percent of TPI (compared with 66.5 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 10.4 percent (compared with 13.2 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.6 percent (compared with 20.3 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 7.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.0 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 6.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in San Patricio increased from \$853,137\* in 2002 to \$948,773\* in 2003, an increase of 11.2 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$479,066\* to the 2003 estimate was 7.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
