



BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

Stonewall , Texas [48433]

Stonewall is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2003 population of 1,430 ranked 243rd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Stonewall had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,136. This PCPI ranked 39th in the state and was 96 percent of the state average, \$29,436, and 89 percent of the national average, \$31,530. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.0 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Stonewall was \$17,856 and ranked 75th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Stonewall had a total personal income (TPI) of \$40,234*. This TPI ranked 240th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Stonewall was \$35,515* and ranked 235th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 1.0 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Stonewall. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 48.7 percent of TPI (compared with 55.2 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 25.6 percent (compared with 25.3 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 25.8 percent (compared with 19.4 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings decreased 0.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.7 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings remained unchanged; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.1 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Stonewall decreased from \$20,038* in 2002 to \$19,378* in 2003, a decrease of 3.3 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$21,530* to the 2003 estimate was - 1.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
