



BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

Willacy , Texas [48489]

Willacy is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the Raymondville, TX Micropolitan SA. Its 2003 population of 19,845 ranked 117th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Willacy had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$17,167. This PCPI ranked 233rd in the state and was 58 percent of the state average, \$29,436, and 54 percent of the national average, \$31,530. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 14.3 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Willacy was \$10,407 and ranked 247th in the state. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Willacy had a total personal income (TPI) of \$340,677*. This TPI ranked 136th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1993 the TPI of Willacy was \$196,490* and ranked 149th in the state. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 14.4 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Willacy. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 58.7 percent of TPI (compared with 56.5 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 9.0 percent (compared with 11.9 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 32.3 percent (compared with 31.7 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 21.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.5 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 6.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.9 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Willacy increased from \$103,856* in 2002 to \$137,774* in 2003, an increase of 32.7 percent. The 2002-2003 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$103,233* to the 2003 estimate was 2.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.
