



BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

Greensboro-Winston-Salem-High Point (BEA-EA) [57066]

Greensboro-Winston-Salem-High Point is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2003 population of 1,836,712 ranked 42nd in the nation.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Greensboro-Winston-Salem-High Point had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$27,327. This PCPI ranked 82nd in the United States and was 87 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 1.7 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Greensboro-Winston-Salem-High Point was \$19,866 and ranked 47th in the United States. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Greensboro-Winston-Salem-High Point had a total personal income (TPI) of \$50,190,946*. This TPI ranked 44th in the United States. In 1993 the TPI of Greensboro-Winston-Salem-High Point was \$32,407,718* and ranked 39th in the United States. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 2.1 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.1 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Greensboro-Winston-Salem-High Point. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 65.7 percent of TPI (compared with 68.0 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.2 percent (compared with 18.3 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.1 percent (compared with 13.8 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 2.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 0.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.3 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 4.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.7 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Greensboro-Winston-Salem-High Point increased from \$36,025,637* in 2002 to \$36,874,223* in 2003, an increase of 2.4 percent. The 2002-2003 national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$24,737,475* to the 2003 estimate was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.3 percent.
