



## **BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003**

### **Jackson-Yazoo City (BEA-EA) [57080]**

Jackson-Yazoo City is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2003 population of 1,655,269 ranked 46th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Jackson-Yazoo City had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,030. This PCPI ranked 167th in the United States and was 73 percent of the national average, \$31,530. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.7 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Jackson-Yazoo City was \$15,137 and ranked 174th in the United States. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2003 Jackson-Yazoo City had a total personal income (TPI) of \$38,121,390\*. This TPI ranked 55th in the United States. In 1993 the TPI of Jackson-Yazoo City was \$24,087,607\* and ranked 54th in the United States. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 3.7 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Jackson-Yazoo City. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 64.0 percent of TPI (compared with 63.8 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.1 percent (compared with 15.4 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 22.9 percent (compared with 20.8 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 6.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 6.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 3.5 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 4.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Jackson-Yazoo City increased from \$25,605,525\* in 2002 to \$27,117,411\* in 2003, an increase of 5.9 percent. The 2002-2003 national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$17,173,073\* to the 2003 estimate was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.3 percent.
