



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area , Alaska [02232]**

Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 3,192 ranked 21st in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$32,300. This PCPI ranked 10th in the state and was 95 percent of the state average, \$33,941, and 97 percent of the national average, \$33,157. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 0.3 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 5.2 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area was \$21,956 and ranked 15th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.1 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area had a total personal income (TPI) of \$103,101\*. This TPI ranked 21st in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area was \$84,112\* and ranked 20th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected a decrease of 0.6 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.9 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 64.9 percent of TPI (compared with 65.2 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.2 percent (compared with 19.1 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.9 percent (compared with 15.7 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings decreased 1.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 3.0 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 2.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area decreased from \$73,115\* in 2003 to \$70,302\* in 2004, a decrease of 3.8 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$61,364\* to the 2004 estimate was 1.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
