



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Ida , Iowa [19093]**

Ida is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 7,301 ranked 93rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Ida had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,643. This PCPI ranked 33rd in the state and was 97 percent of the state average, \$30,698, and 89 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 11.3 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Ida was \$18,551 and ranked 60th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Ida had a total personal income (TPI) of \$216,426\*. This TPI ranked 89th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Ida was \$154,582\* and ranked 86th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 9.1 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.8 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Ida. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 63.5 percent of TPI (compared with 64.1 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.7 percent (compared with 20.5 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.8 percent (compared with 15.4 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 15.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 2.7 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 3.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Ida increased from \$147,183\* in 2003 to \$164,757\* in 2004, an increase of 11.9 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 9.6 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$120,632\* to the 2004 estimate was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
