



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Grant , Nebraska [31075]**

Grant is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 658 ranked 89th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Grant had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$14,357. This PCPI ranked 92nd in the state and was 45 percent of the state average, \$31,827, and 43 percent of the national average, \$33,157. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.4 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 3.3 percent and the national change was 5.2 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Grant was \$8,222 and ranked 92nd in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Grant had a total personal income (TPI) of \$9,447\*. This TPI ranked 90th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Grant was \$6,528\* and ranked 90th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 0.9 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Grant. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 9.7 percent of TPI (compared with 11.8 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 56.2 percent (compared with 58.4 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 34.1 percent (compared with 29.8 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings decreased 10.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 1.4 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 1.8 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.1 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Grant decreased from \$1,801\* in 2003 to \$1,746\* in 2004, a decrease of 3.1 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.2 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$1,122\* to the 2004 estimate was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
