



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Onslow , North Carolina [37133]**

Onslow is one of 100 counties in North Carolina. It is part of the [Jacksonville, NC \(MSA\)](#). Its 2004 population of 162,165 ranked 10th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Onslow had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,752. This PCPI ranked 29th in the state and was 91 percent of the state average, \$29,387, and 81 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 8.4 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Onslow was \$17,449 and ranked 51st in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.7 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Onslow had a total personal income (TPI) of \$4,338,174\*. This TPI ranked 12th in the state and accounted for 1.7 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Onslow was \$2,560,832\* and ranked 13th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 12.1 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 6.8 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Onslow. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 78.1 percent of TPI (compared with 79.0 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 9.7 percent (compared with 12.0 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.2 percent (compared with 9.0 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 15.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 4.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 9.6 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 5.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Onslow increased from \$3,253,656\* in 2003 to \$3,747,526\* in 2004, an increase of 15.2 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 6.1 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$2,256,571\* to the 2004 estimate was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
