



BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004

Roberts , Texas [48393]

Roberts is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the Pampa, TX Micropolitan SA. Its 2004 population of 816 ranked 248th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2004 Roberts had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,594. This PCPI ranked 51st in the state and was 92 percent of the state average, \$30,989, and 86 percent of the national average, \$33,157. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.7 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 5.2 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Roberts was \$17,114 and ranked 103rd in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2004 Roberts had a total personal income (TPI) of \$23,333*. This TPI ranked 248th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Roberts was \$16,772* and ranked 248th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 12.3 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.4 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Roberts. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 71.6 percent of TPI (compared with 65.1 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.7 percent (compared with 21.9 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 12.7 percent (compared with 13.0 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 15.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 1.2 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 4.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent remained unchanged; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.1 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Roberts increased from \$7,545* in 2003 to \$8,953* in 2004, an increase of 18.7 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$7,853* to the 2004 estimate was 1.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
