



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Mecklenburg , Virginia [51117]**

Mecklenburg is one of 105 counties in Virginia. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 32,081 ranked 50th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Mecklenburg had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$22,991. This PCPI ranked 78th in the state and was 64 percent of the state average, \$35,841, and 69 percent of the national average, \$33,123. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.8 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 5.4 percent and the national change was 5.1 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Mecklenburg was \$16,534 and ranked 72nd in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Mecklenburg had a total personal income (TPI) of \$737,573\*. This TPI ranked 55th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Mecklenburg was \$508,891\* and ranked 51st in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 2.5 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 6.7 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Mecklenburg. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 56.7 percent of TPI (compared with 60.3 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 17.8 percent (compared with 19.4 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 25.5 percent (compared with 20.3 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 3.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 0.9 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 3.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Mecklenburg increased from \$437,623\* in 2003 to \$446,319\* in 2004, an increase of 2.0 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 8.7 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$350,919\* to the 2004 estimate was 2.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.3 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
