



## **BEARFACTS 1994 – 2004**

### **Adams , Wisconsin [55001]**

Adams is one of 72 counties in Wisconsin. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2004 population of 20,317 ranked 52nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Adams had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,945. This PCPI ranked 63rd in the state and was 76 percent of the state average, \$31,705, and 72 percent of the national average, \$33,157. The 2004 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.9 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 3.2 percent and the national change was 5.2 percent. In 1994 the PCPI of Adams was \$15,380 and ranked 65th in the state. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2004 Adams had a total personal income (TPI) of \$486,486\*. This TPI ranked 54th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1994 the TPI of Adams was \$262,236\* and ranked 59th in the state. The 2004 TPI reflected an increase of 4.0 percent from 2003. The 2003-2004 state change was 3.9 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. The 1994-2004 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Adams. In 2004 net earnings accounted for 61.5 percent of TPI (compared with 61.2 in 1994); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.0 percent (compared with 15.8 in 1994); and personal current transfer receipts were 23.6 percent (compared with 22.9 in 1994). From 2003 to 2004 net earnings increased 4.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 0.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.9 percent. From 1994 to 2004 net earnings increased on average 6.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 5.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Adams increased from \$209,444\* in 2003 to \$218,564\* in 2004, an increase of 4.4 percent. The 2003-2004 state change was 4.7 percent and the national change was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1994 estimate of \$118,693\* to the 2004 estimate was 6.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
