



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Anniston-Oxford (MSA) [11500]**

Anniston-Oxford is one of 363 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2005 population of 111,953 ranked 316th in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Anniston-Oxford had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$27,528. This PCPI ranked 267th in the United States and was 79 percent of the national average, \$34,690. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.0 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 4.6 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Anniston-Oxford was \$17,967 and ranked 316th in the United States. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Anniston-Oxford had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,081,865\*. This TPI ranked 317th in the United States. In 1995 the TPI of Anniston-Oxford was \$2,098,385\* and ranked 296th in the United States. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 4.4 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.6 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Anniston-Oxford. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 62.9 percent of TPI (compared with 64.1 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 15.2 percent (compared with 17.5 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.9 percent (compared with 18.5 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 5.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 2.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.7 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 3.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.5 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Anniston-Oxford increased from \$2,181,036\* in 2004 to \$2,318,918\* in 2005, an increase of 6.3 percent. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$1,637,475\* to the 2005 estimate was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
