



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Scurry , Texas [48415]**

Scurry is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the Snyder, TX Micropolitan SA. Its 2005 population of 15,780 ranked 135th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Scurry had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$32,690. This PCPI ranked 27th in the state and was 98 percent of the state average, \$33,253, and 94 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 11.5 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Scurry was \$16,933 and ranked 125th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 6.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Scurry had a total personal income (TPI) of \$515,853\*. This TPI ranked 117th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Scurry was \$299,766\* and ranked 118th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 10.9 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 9.3 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.7 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Scurry. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 71.5 percent of TPI (compared with 59.4 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.6 percent (compared with 21.3 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.9 percent (compared with 19.3 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 21.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 23.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.7 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 7.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 4.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Scurry increased from \$339,582\* in 2004 to \$412,284\* in 2005, an increase of 21.4 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$200,619\* to the 2005 estimate was 7.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.9 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
