



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Sutton , Texas [48435]**

Sutton is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2005 population of 4,202 ranked 208th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Sutton had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$27,632. This PCPI ranked 84th in the state and was 83 percent of the state average, \$33,253, and 80 percent of the national average, \$34,757. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 8.5 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Sutton was \$16,117 and ranked 160th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Sutton had a total personal income (TPI) of \$116,108\*. This TPI ranked 205th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Sutton was \$70,270\* and ranked 211th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 10.5 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 9.3 percent and the national change was 5.9 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.7 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Sutton. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 71.2 percent of TPI (compared with 58.7 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 12.8 percent (compared with 26.1 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 16.0 percent (compared with 15.2 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 16.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 12.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.2 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 7.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 2.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Sutton increased from \$90,826\* in 2004 to \$106,829\* in 2005, an increase of 17.6 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$51,242\* to the 2005 estimate was 7.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.9 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
