



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Piute , Utah [49031]**

Piute is one of 29 counties in Utah. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2005 population of 1,362 ranked 28th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Piute had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$23,261. This PCPI ranked 18th in the state and was 83 percent of the state average, \$27,885, and 67 percent of the national average, \$34,690. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.9 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 4.6 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Piute was \$13,111 and ranked 26th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Piute had a total personal income (TPI) of \$31,682\*. This TPI ranked 28th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Piute was \$18,381\* and ranked 28th in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 8.9 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 9.7 percent and the national change was 5.6 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Piute. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 61.9 percent of TPI (compared with 54.4 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.8 percent (compared with 21.1 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.3 percent (compared with 24.5 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 10.3 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 1.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 11.0 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 7.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.3 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Piute increased from \$15,678\* in 2004 to \$17,584\* in 2005, an increase of 12.2 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 8.0 percent and the national change was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$8,659\* to the 2005 estimate was 7.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
