



## **BEARFACTS 1995 – 2005**

### **Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent (BEA-EA) [57125]**

Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2005 population of 677,474 ranked 93rd in the nation.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,870. This PCPI ranked 80th in the United States and was 86 percent of the national average, \$34,690. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.1 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 4.6 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent was \$18,739 and ranked 117th in the United States. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.2 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2005 Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent had a total personal income (TPI) of \$20,236,211\*. This TPI ranked 93rd in the United States. In 1995 the TPI of Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent was \$10,825,369\* and ranked 100th in the United States. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 7.3 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.6 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.3 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 64.7 percent of TPI (compared with 65.2 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.2 percent (compared with 18.9 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.1 percent (compared with 15.9 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 8.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 23.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 7.9 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 6.4 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 6.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.2 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Pensacola-Ferry Pass-Brent increased from \$13,367,281\* in 2004 to \$14,455,205\* in 2005, an increase of 8.1 percent. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.3 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$7,820,631\* to the 2005 estimate was 6.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.
