



## **BEARFACTS 1996 – 2006**

### **Lyman , South Dakota [46085]**

Lyman is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2006 population of 3,859 ranked 42nd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2006 Lyman had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$19,507. This PCPI ranked 58th in the state and was 60 percent of the state average, \$32,293, and 53 percent of the national average, \$36,794. The 2006 PCPI reflected a decrease of 19.6 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 0.3 percent and the national change was 6.1 percent. In 1996 the PCPI of Lyman was \$19,270 and ranked 40th in the state. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 0.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2006 Lyman had a total personal income (TPI) of \$75,276\*. This TPI ranked 49th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1996 the TPI of Lyman was \$74,844\* and ranked 44th in the state. The 2006 TPI reflected a decrease of 19.2 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 1.3 percent and the national change was 7.1 percent. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of TPI was 0.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Lyman. In 2006 net earnings accounted for 54.1 percent of TPI (compared with 62.3 in 1996); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.1 percent (compared with 21.0 in 1996); and personal current transfer receipts were 26.8 percent (compared with 16.6 in 1996). From 2005 to 2006 net earnings decreased 30.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 7.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.2 percent. From 1996 to 2006 net earnings decreased on average 1.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 0.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.0 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Lyman decreased from \$59,731\* in 2005 to \$41,616\* in 2006, a decrease of 30.3 percent. The 2005-2006 state change was - 0.9 percent and the national change was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1996 estimate of \$45,671\* to the 2006 estimate was - 0.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.
