



BEARFACTS 1996 – 2006

Baton Rouge-Pierre Part (BEA-EA) [57015]

Baton Rouge-Pierre Part is one of 179 BEA Economic Areas in the nation. Its 2006 population of 796,953 ranked 86th in the nation.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2006 Baton Rouge-Pierre Part had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$31,920. This PCPI ranked 75th in the United States and was 87 percent of the national average, \$36,794. The 2006 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.8 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 national change was 6.1 percent. In 1996 the PCPI of Baton Rouge-Pierre Part was \$20,752 and ranked 87th in the United States. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2006 Baton Rouge-Pierre Part had a total personal income (TPI) of \$25,438,346*. This TPI ranked 81st in the United States. In 1996 the TPI of Baton Rouge-Pierre Part was \$14,750,096* and ranked 86th in the United States. The 2006 TPI reflected an increase of 11.7 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 national change was 7.1 percent. The 1996-2006 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Baton Rouge-Pierre Part. In 2006 net earnings accounted for 68.1 percent of TPI (compared with 68.8 in 1996); dividends, interest, and rent were 14.8 percent (compared with 16.3 in 1996); and personal current transfer receipts were 17.1 percent (compared with 14.8 in 1996). From 2005 to 2006 net earnings increased 11.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 42.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts decreased 4.7 percent. From 1996 to 2006 net earnings increased on average 5.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 7.1 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Baton Rouge-Pierre Part increased from \$17,206,661* in 2005 to \$19,170,303* in 2006, an increase of 11.4 percent. The 2005-2006 national change was 5.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1996 estimate of \$11,280,749* to the 2006 estimate was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.
