



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area , Alaska [02232]

Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area is one of 27 counties in Alaska. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 3,114 ranked 21st in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$39,906. This PCPI ranked 11th in the state and was 100 percent of the state average, \$40,042, and 103 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 7.8 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 4.4 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area was \$25,046 and ranked 9th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.1 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area had a total personal income (TPI) of \$124,266*. This TPI ranked 21st in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area was \$92,895* and ranked 20th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 8.0 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.2 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.2 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 68.7 percent of TPI (compared with 65.0 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.0 percent (compared with 19.7 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.3 percent (compared with 15.3 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 8.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 2.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.5 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 3.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 2.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.9 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Skagway-Hoonah-Angoon Census Area increased from \$83,330* in 2006 to \$89,471* in 2007, an increase of 7.4 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 4.5 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$66,644* to the 2007 estimate was 3.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.4 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
