



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Lafayette , Florida [12067]

Lafayette is one of 67 counties in Florida. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 7,957 ranked 66th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Lafayette had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$17,196. This PCPI ranked 66th in the state and was 45 percent of the state average, \$38,417, and 45 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.6 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 3.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Lafayette was \$15,443 and ranked 58th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 1.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Lafayette had a total personal income (TPI) of \$136,830*. This TPI ranked 67th in the state and accounted for 0.0 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Lafayette was \$97,787* and ranked 67th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 10.7 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 4.6 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Lafayette. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 61.5 percent of TPI (compared with 67.5 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.5 percent (compared with 13.7 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 24.9 percent (compared with 18.8 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 13.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.5 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 2.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.4 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Lafayette increased from \$65,431* in 2006 to \$74,450* in 2007, an increase of 13.8 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 2.5 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$60,423* to the 2007 estimate was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
