



## **BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007 Republic , Kansas [20157]**

Republic is one of 105 counties in Kansas. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 4,899 ranked 69th in the state.

### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 Republic had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,391. This PCPI ranked 71st in the state and was 78 percent of the state average, \$36,525, and 74 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.3 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Republic was \$20,199 and ranked 67th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 Republic had a total personal income (TPI) of \$139,089\*. This TPI ranked 71st in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Republic was \$122,383\* and ranked 67th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 8.8 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 1.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Republic. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 58.9 percent of TPI (compared with 53.2 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.1 percent (compared with 25.8 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 25.1 percent (compared with 20.9 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 12.7 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.1 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 2.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 3.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.1 percent.

### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Republic increased from \$78,591\* in 2006 to \$87,889\* in 2007, an increase of 11.8 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.4 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$70,651\* to the 2007 estimate was 2.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
