



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Henry , Kentucky [21103]

Henry is one of 120 counties in Kentucky. It is part of the [Louisville-Jefferson County, KY-IN \(MSA\)](#). Its 2007 population of 15,667 ranked 74th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Henry had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,998. This PCPI ranked 42nd in the state and was 88 percent of the state average, \$30,824, and 70 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.2 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 4.3 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Henry was \$19,595 and ranked 29th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Henry had a total personal income (TPI) of \$422,984*. This TPI ranked 65th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Henry was \$287,398* and ranked 63rd in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Henry. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 68.4 percent of TPI (compared with 67.5 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 10.2 percent (compared with 15.0 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.4 percent (compared with 17.5 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 1.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 4.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.5 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 4.1 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent remained unchanged; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Henry increased from \$157,392* in 2006 to \$159,141* in 2007, an increase of 1.1 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 4.3 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$117,406* to the 2007 estimate was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.9 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
