



## **BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007**

### **Judith Basin , Montana [30045]**

Judith Basin is one of 56 counties in Montana. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 2,040 ranked 43rd in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 Judith Basin had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$27,633. This PCPI ranked 36th in the state and was 83 percent of the state average, \$33,225, and 72 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 22.5 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 7.0 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Judith Basin was \$17,577 and ranked 32nd in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 Judith Basin had a total personal income (TPI) of \$56,371\*. This TPI ranked 45th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Judith Basin was \$41,006\* and ranked 45th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 17.8 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 8.2 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.0 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Judith Basin. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 48.2 percent of TPI (compared with 46.5 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 30.4 percent (compared with 36.7 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 21.3 percent (compared with 16.9 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 28.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 8.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.5 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 3.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.3 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Judith Basin increased from \$16,728\* in 2006 to \$22,580\* in 2007, an increase of 35.0 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 7.2 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$16,561\* to the 2007 estimate was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.3 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
