



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Adams , Nebraska [31001]

Adams is one of 93 counties in Nebraska. It is part of the Hastings, NE Micropolitan SA. Its 2007 population of 32,869 ranked 10th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Adams had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,371. This PCPI ranked 53rd in the state and was 81 percent of the state average, \$36,372, and 76 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.5 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Adams was \$21,508 and ranked 36th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.2 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Adams had a total personal income (TPI) of \$965,395*. This TPI ranked 11th in the state and accounted for 1.5 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Adams was \$667,824* and ranked 11th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 9.5 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.7 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Adams. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 58.6 percent of TPI (compared with 59.9 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 22.7 percent (compared with 24.9 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 18.8 percent (compared with 15.2 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 10.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 7.0 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 3.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 2.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Adams increased from \$616,370* in 2006 to \$680,270* in 2007, an increase of 10.4 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$470,750* to the 2007 estimate was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
