



## **BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007**

### **White Pine , Nevada [32033]**

White Pine is one of 17 counties in Nevada. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 9,112 ranked 10th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 White Pine had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$37,176. This PCPI ranked 7th in the state and was 93 percent of the state average, \$39,853, and 96 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.1 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 2.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of White Pine was \$21,530 and ranked 12th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 White Pine had a total personal income (TPI) of \$338,748\*. This TPI ranked 10th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of White Pine was \$217,410\* and ranked 10th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 9.7 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.5 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.9 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of White Pine. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 73.6 percent of TPI (compared with 70.7 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.3 percent (compared with 16.1 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 15.1 percent (compared with 13.3 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 11.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 6.9 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 5.0 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in White Pine increased from \$207,726\* in 2006 to \$226,904\* in 2007, an increase of 9.2 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.1 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$157,872\* to the 2007 estimate was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 7.6 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
