



## **BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007**

### **Hand , South Dakota [46059]**

Hand is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 3,270 ranked 46th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 Hand had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$42,466. This PCPI ranked 8th in the state and was 119 percent of the state average, \$35,760, and 110 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 58.3 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 10.7 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Hand was \$20,968 and ranked 30th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 7.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 Hand had a total personal income (TPI) of \$138,865\*. This TPI ranked 38th in the state and accounted for 0.5 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Hand was \$82,342\* and ranked 41st in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 57.7 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 11.9 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 5.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Hand. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 65.3 percent of TPI (compared with 50.1 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 19.9 percent (compared with 32.9 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.8 percent (compared with 17.1 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 108.1 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 10.7 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 5.3 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 8.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 0.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 3.9 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in Hand increased from \$46,431\* in 2006 to \$93,657\* in 2007, an increase of 101.7 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 12.2 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$43,141\* to the 2007 estimate was 8.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
