



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Lincoln , South Dakota [46083]

Lincoln is one of 66 counties in South Dakota. It is part of the [Sioux Falls, SD \(MSA\)](#). Its 2007 population of 37,732 ranked 3rd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Lincoln had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$40,366. This PCPI ranked 9th in the state and was 113 percent of the state average, \$35,760, and 105 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 7.0 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 10.7 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Lincoln was \$26,482 and ranked 3rd in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Lincoln had a total personal income (TPI) of \$1,523,108*. This TPI ranked 4th in the state and accounted for 5.4 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Lincoln was \$538,952* and ranked 6th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 13.1 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 11.9 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 10.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.7 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Lincoln. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 75.7 percent of TPI (compared with 78.4 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 18.2 percent (compared with 13.9 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 6.1 percent (compared with 7.7 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 13.6 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 11.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.5 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 10.6 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 14.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 8.4 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Lincoln increased from \$562,507* in 2006 to \$667,071* in 2007, an increase of 18.6 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 12.2 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$193,250* to the 2007 estimate was 13.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.5 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
