



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007 Hancock , Tennessee [47067]

Hancock is one of 95 counties in Tennessee. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 6,717 ranked 92nd in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Hancock had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$15,967. This PCPI ranked 95th in the state and was 48 percent of the state average, \$33,395, and 41 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.7 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Hancock was \$12,802 and ranked 94th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.9 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Hancock had a total personal income (TPI) of \$107,252*. This TPI ranked 94th in the state and accounted for 0.1 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Hancock was \$87,204* and ranked 93rd in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 4.0 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.2 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 2.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Hancock. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 45.3 percent of TPI (compared with 53.1 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 7.8 percent (compared with 11.5 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 46.9 percent (compared with 35.4 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings decreased 1.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 10.2 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 0.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent decreased on average 1.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Hancock decreased from \$29,900* in 2006 to \$29,229* in 2007, a decrease of 2.2 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$34,440* to the 2007 estimate was - 1.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
