



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Williamson , Tennessee [47187]

Williamson is one of 95 counties in Tennessee. It is part of the [Nashville-Davidson-Murfreesboro-Franklin, TN \(MSA\)](#). Its 2007 population of 165,690 ranked 6th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Williamson had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$54,755. This PCPI ranked 1st in the state and was 164 percent of the state average, \$33,395, and 142 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.3 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 3.8 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Williamson was \$35,442 and ranked 1st in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.9 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Williamson had a total personal income (TPI) of \$9,072,300*. This TPI ranked 5th in the state and accounted for 4.4 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Williamson was \$3,925,955* and ranked 5th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 8.8 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.2 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 8.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Williamson. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 77.2 percent of TPI (compared with 78.9 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.7 percent (compared with 15.6 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 6.1 percent (compared with 5.5 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 7.8 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 12.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 11.4 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 8.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 9.4 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 10.0 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Williamson increased from \$5,396,589* in 2006 to \$6,036,256* in 2007, an increase of 11.9 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$2,177,380* to the 2007 estimate was 10.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 5.1 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
