



## **BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007**

### **San Patricio , Texas [48409]**

San Patricio is one of 254 counties in Texas. It is part of the [Corpus Christi, TX \(MSA\)](#). Its 2007 population of 68,385 ranked 50th in the state.

#### **PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 San Patricio had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,272. This PCPI ranked 122nd in the state and was 79 percent of the state average, \$37,083, and 76 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 8.3 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.5 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of San Patricio was \$16,886 and ranked 192nd in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 5.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

#### **TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

In 2007 San Patricio had a total personal income (TPI) of \$2,001,737\*. This TPI ranked 50th in the state and accounted for 0.2 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of San Patricio was \$1,113,642\* and ranked 50th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 8.1 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 6.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.6 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

#### **COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME**

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of San Patricio. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 68.7 percent of TPI (compared with 67.5 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 10.6 percent (compared with 12.8 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.7 percent (compared with 19.7 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 8.5 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 5.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.3 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 6.2 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 4.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 6.6 percent.

#### **EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK**

Earnings of persons employed in San Patricio increased from \$1,022,644\* in 2006 to \$1,103,391\* in 2007, an increase of 7.9 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 7.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$676,534\* to the 2007 estimate was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.8 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
