



BEARFACTS 1997 – 2007

Duchesne , Utah [49013]

Duchesne is one of 29 counties in Utah. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 16,187 ranked 16th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Duchesne had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$32,996. This PCPI ranked 3rd in the state and was 111 percent of the state average, \$29,831, and 85 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.7 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 2.0 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Duchesne was \$16,725 and ranked 16th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 7.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.8 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Duchesne had a total personal income (TPI) of \$534,106*. This TPI ranked 14th in the state and accounted for 0.7 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Duchesne was \$234,571* and ranked 16th in the state. The 2007 TPI reflected an increase of 16.1 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 5.3 percent and the national change was 6.0 percent. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of TPI was 8.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.2 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Duchesne. In 2007 net earnings accounted for 77.5 percent of TPI (compared with 65.2 in 1997); dividends, interest, and rent were 8.3 percent (compared with 15.7 in 1997); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.2 percent (compared with 19.0 in 1997). From 2006 to 2007 net earnings increased 19.9 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 5.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.2 percent. From 1997 to 2007 net earnings increased on average 10.5 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.8 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.4 percent.

EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Duchesne increased from \$325,519* in 2006 to \$399,320* in 2007, an increase of 22.7 percent. The 2006-2007 state change was 7.4 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1997 estimate of \$150,784* to the 2007 estimate was 10.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 6.5 percent and for the nation was 5.4 percent.
