

Schenectady, New York

Personal income last published on November 17, 2016.

Schenectady is one of 62 counties in New York. It is part of the Albany-Schenectady-Troy, NY Metropolitan Statistical Area. Its 2015 population of 154,604 ranked 22nd in the state.


Per Capita Personal Income

In 2015, Schenectady had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$48,206. This PCPI ranked 13th in the state and was 82 percent of the state average, \$58,670, and 100 percent of the national average, \$48,112. The 2015 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.5 percent from 2014. The 2014-2015 state change was 3.5 percent and the national change was 3.7 percent. In 2005, the PCPI of Schenectady was \$39,134 and ranked 8th in the state. The 2005-2015 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 2.1 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 3.5 percent and for the nation was 3.0 percent.


Personal Income

In 2015, Schenectady had a personal income of \$7,452,800*. This personal income ranked 21st in the state and accounted for 0.6 percent of the state total. In 2005, the personal income of Schenectady was \$5,877,940* and ranked 19th in the state.

Personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Schenectady.
